Free, Hands-on Training Program on Water Quality Analysis for Higher Secondary School Students

Sophisticated Test and Instrumentation Centre (STIC), CUSAT Campus, Kochi is pleased to announce the launch of free, one-day hands-on training program for high school students on water quality analysis, as part of the "Kerala Sustainable Lifestyle Workshop: Enhancing Environmental Education through Water Quality Analysis Workshops.". This program is sponsored by Kerala State Council for Science, Technology & Environment (KSCSTE) – in collaboration with Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF & CC) - Environmental Education Programme (EEP) under the National Green Corps initiative.

Science aspiring Higher secondary school students can apply for this program. The program aims to train 200 students through four one-day sessions designed for 50 participants per day. Admission will be granted to different schools, comprising 50 students per day.

The program is scheduled at the Sophisticated Test and Instrumentation Centre (STIC), CUSAT campus, Kalamassery, Cochin 682022, from January 3 to January 6, 2024.

The program is completely free and the participants will be offered a working lunch, tea, snacks, and study materials along with certificate of participation.

Participation requests are accepted only through schools, and admission will be on a first-come, first-served basis. The application may be submitted by the Principal of the school concerned to the Director, Sophisticated Test and Instrumentation Centre (STIC), Cochin University Campus, Cochin University PO, Kochi – 682022.
