Free Skill Based Training on Water Testing

Date : 8 to 19 June 2026.

(For Candidates from SC/ST communities and other backward class from rural villages)

The Sophisticated Test and Instrumentation Centre (STIC) at Cochin University Campus, Cochin, and the Environmental Information, Awareness Capacity Building and Livelihood Programme (EIACP) Centre hub, KSCSTE, Kerala-Capacity Building Programme (CBP) are jointly conducting a **Free Skill Based Training on Water Testing.**

The programme is sponsored by KSCSTE and MoEF&CC, Government of India.

Date : 8 to 19 June 2026.

Eligibility:

Candidates belonging to SC/ST communities and Other Backward Classes (OBC) from rural areas, possessing a degree in Chemistry, Microbiology, Food Technology, or related disciplines, are eligible to apply. Only OBC candidates from Gram Panchayat/rural areas are eligible under the OBC category.

Age : 45 years

Nature of course : Both Theory and Practical sessions

No. of Participants: Limited to **10 students** from various districts of Kerala.

Facilities provided :

Food, Accommodation and Travel Allowance (TA) will be provided to all selected participants.

Selection Criteria :

Selection will be based on marks obtained in the qualifying examination. If the number of applicants is high, a **test/interview** will be conducted. OBC candidates will be considered only when sufficient applicants from SC/ST category are not available. OBC candidates from Grama Panchayath/rural villages only will be considered.
